- High School transcripts
- Proof of acceptance/attendance to a credited college or university
- Any additional information to aid the Scholarship Committee in the selection process.

- ❑ High School Transcripts/Proof of acceptance to a credited college or university.
- ❑ A scholarship application must be completed which includes two (2) letters of recommendation and a grade transcript and returned to Financial Builders by **April 1, 2020**
