Selections and awards will be based on applicant needs and available funds. Applicants must present appropriate proof of need. Applicants are also selected on the basis of academic achievement and community involvement.

Complete applications must include the following:

- A completed application form including applicant's and a parent's or guardian's signature
- High School transcripts
- Proof of acceptance/attendance to a credited college or university
- Any additional information to aid the Scholarship Committee in the selection process.
